



## **QUALCOMM EMC Social Entrepreneur Internship Program**

Direct Paid Internship

Graduate Students Currently Enrolled

\$15.00 per hour – 10-20 hrs/wk

Each semester, including summer, the **QUALCOMM EMC Social Entrepreneur Internship Program** places second-year MS/MBA students (must have completed the core courses or equivalent) with non-profit organizations to manage significant strategic projects in an entrepreneurial setting.

This unique opportunity teams interns up with faculty advisors, a mentor from QUALCOMM or another leading entrepreneurial company and the non-profit agency. Actual summer 2007 project descriptions will be available for review by April 20.

Internships pay \$15/hour for 150 hours (10 - 20 hours/week) and may be eligible for course credit (e.g. BA780; please contact professor for enrollment details).

Applications for the Summer 2007 program are due no later than May 4, 2007. Interviews are coordinated through the EMC and will take place on Friday, May 18 at the SDSU Career Services offices.

A student orientation meeting will be held at the EMC on Wednesday, May 23 from 1:00 – 2:00pm and a team kick off breakfast meeting will be held on Friday, May 25 for interns and organizations.

If a match is made, paperwork is coordinated by the EMC and the student is hired through SDSU Foundation.
